## A MIX & DESIGN



Remove safety seal from under the bottle lid.

Save seal for storage after use.



Measure out **one heaping spoonful** of Part A Silicone Jelly.

Heaping spoonful: Fill slightly over the brim of the spoon without spilling over.



After each pour, use the spatula to scrape the silicone from the spoon into the bowl.

Repeat steps 1 & 2 with Part B.



**SLOWLY** mix together with the spatula. Avoid lifting the spatula from the bowl.

Stir 15 circles to the left then 15 to the right. Scrape the bowl sides as you go.



Pour within **20 minutes** of mixing or the silicone will get too sticky to use!



Pour a **SMALL** amount of mixed silicone into the shape, enough to **cover the bottom**.



Place one design in the shape **FACE DOWN**.

Reference back panel for suggested design and mold combinations.

Use the poker to ensure the design is in the center.



Sprinkle desired glitter over the design.

Focus on the **outer edges** of the mold. This will make the mix-ins more visible in the finished charm.



Fill the mold to the brim of the cavity with the silicone.

**Do not overflow.**

## B SNAP IN PLACE




Snap a post into the center of the bridge, **flat solid larger side up**.



Pinch bridge and insert into the side indents of the mold. **Slide up** until it clicks into place.

TIP: Slightly wiggle the bridge back and forth to snap in easier.



The bridge needs to snap in between the ring and top of the post.

Top of post will be flush with the bridge.



Gently, press down for at least 30 seconds on the post to ensure the bottom is **submerged** into the silicone.



Ensure arrows on the bridge and the mold are pointing in the same direction.

**STOP**

Wait 24 hours for the charm to dry!

\*Dry time may increase with temperatures under 70°F.



**CLEAN-UP**

Once done, let the silicone completely dry on all the tools. Once it sets, you will be able to peel the dry silicone off.

Use paper towels between mixings to wipe down tools.

## C REVEAL

24 hours later



Remove the bridge from the charm by pulling it away from the post.



Press the spatula between the charm and the mold to pop it out!

An adult may be helpful for this step!



Reveal your finished charm. Repeat all steps to make more!

**Remember**

+ 1 spoonful Part A  
+ 1 spoonful Part B  
= 1 charm

**WHAT'S INCLUDED**

**BEFORE YOU START!**

- Read through all directions and watch the QR code video.
- For better results, wash the molds with mild dish soap and water, and dry with a paper towel.
- Lay out all components included.
- Cover your workspace. (cardboard, parchment paper)
- Parts A & B Silicone Jelly may stain some surfaces. So where a smock or apron if you have one!
- Have paper towels or napkins on hand for easy clean up.
- Reference below to choose your first design and mold!

**Suggested Combinations**  
 ★ Mix and match shapes and designs to create more unique combinations.



**QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

- Q: How do I prolong the life of my handmade charm?**  
 A: When removing, press from the plastic post side and NOT from the silicone side. Remember, push don't pull!
- Q: Where do I store the silicone when I am not using it?**  
 A: Replace the plastic safety seal on bottles and store upright at room temperature. Use the clear storage bag for all supplies!
- Q: When do I know the silicone is dry?**  
 A: If the charm does not release it may need more time to dry. The finished output should feel flexible, but not wet and should not leave residue on the mold.
- Q: Why is the silicone not coming out of the bottle?**  
 A: If the silicone jelly is not coming out of the bottle, ensure you have removed the plastic safety seal under the cap.
- Q: Why is my charm not drying after 24 hours?**  
 A: Make sure to use equal parts of both A and B to create your charms, or they may not set properly.

Close the A & B Silicone tightly and store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and open flames.  
**CAUTION:** Do not rinse containers or dispose of unused material in sinks, toilets, or any plumbing. Silicone may cure inside pipes and cause blockages. Dispose of contents and containers in accordance with local regulations.

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
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
